Placement Criteria for Mathematics, ESL & English

MATHEMATICS PLACEMENT SEQUENCE (Prior to Spring 2017)

- Students who take M2 and score 40 and above go to College Level Math.
- Students who take M2 and score between 35-39 take the pilot MAT 115 or MAT 120SI.
- Students who take M2 and score less than 35 and more than 45 on M1 go to MAT 20. Students should only take MAT 20 once.
- Students who take M2 and score less than 35 and score between 35-44 on the M1 should take MAT 15.
- Students who take M2 and score less than 35 and score less than 35 on the M1 should take MAT 10.
- Students who take MAT 20 and get a "P" go to College Level Math.
- Students who take MAT 20 and get "NP" take the pilot MAT 115 or MAT 120SI.
- Students who take MAT 20 and get an "R" take MAT 22.
- Students who take MAT 22 (0 credit 3 equated/billable) and get a "P" go to College Level Math.
- Students who take MAT 22 and get "NP" take the pilot MAT 115 or MAT 120SI.
- Students who take MAT 22 and get an "R" repeat MAT 22.
- ➢ S= Superior- Go to College Level Math
- \blacktriangleright P = Pass- Go to College Level Math
- > NP= Not Pass repeat or take MAT 20
- ➢ NC= No Credit
- \triangleright R=Repeat
- \blacktriangleright U= Multiple repeats

MATHEMATICS PLACEMENT SEQUENCE – ACCUPLACER (Submitted January 10, 2018).

- ➤ MAT 10 Students who did not pass M1 and received an Accuplacer score between 0-31.
- MAT 15 Combines MAT 10 and MAT 20 curricula: Students who did not pass M1 and M2 but received a score close to passing M1. Accuplacer score between 32-39. Students who pass are able to enroll in college-level math.
- MAT 20 Students who have successfully completed MAT10 and those who scored 40-56 on the Accuplacer. Students who pass are able to enroll in college-level math.
- MAT 119 (3 credits) Co-requisite MAT 19 (0 credit 1.5 billable/equated), Students who have successfully completed MAT10 and those who scored 40-56 on the Accuplacer.

ESL 93 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- ESL 93 (3 credits, 6 equated/billable)
- For continuing students that attempted ESL 91 at least once and failed the CAT-W with score of 48-55.
- For continuing students who have completed ESL 35 (ESL 36 OR ESL 37) or ESL 82 or ESL 84 or ESL 86, or ESL 88 and failed the CAT-W with score of 48-55.
- First-semester students who have placed in ESL 91and failed the CAT-W with score of 48-55.

ESL 94 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- ► ESL 94 (1 credit, 3 equated/billable).
- For continuing students who have completed ESL 92, or ESL 82 or ESL 84 or ESL 86, or ESL 88, with a high-failing R grade; students with a 60-69 % on the CUNY CAT-R exam.
- First-semester students who have been placed in the ESL 91/93 level (level 4 and 5).

ESL 95 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- ESL 95 (1 credit, 3 equated/billable) is a pilot course for students who took ESL 91 twice and did not pass the CAT-W examination.
- Students will be required to commit to a 20-hour intervention in the Writing Center in order to be eligible to retake the test.

ESL 96 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- > ESL 96 (1 credit, 3 equated/billable).
- ➢ For continuing students with at least one "R" grade in ESL 92, and failed the CAT- R reading examination with a score of 60-69.
- For continuing students who have completed ESL 35 (ESL 36 OR ESL 37) or ESL 82 or ESL 84 or ESL 86, or ESL 88, and failed the CAT- R reading examination with a score of 60-69.
- First-semester students who have placed in ESL 91 or have passed the CAT-W and have failed the CAT- R reading examination with a score of 60-69.

ENG 93 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- ENG 93 (0 credit, 6 equated/billable) is open to all developmental students in English who did not meet the criteria for ENG 101 and ENG 102.
- If a student passes ENG 93 (passing the course and one or both of the required test) the prerequisites will be satisfied for any course that has ENG 91 and ENG 92 as a pre-requisite.
- For spring 2015, ENG 93 will satisfy the co-requisites for any course that has ENG 91 and ENG 92 as a co-requisite.

ENG 100 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA (Pilot Course – Spring 2018)

- > ENG 100 (3 credits, 6 equated/billable)
- > Passed the CAT-W exam and scored 41-54 on the Accuplacer Reading exam.
- > Passed the Accuplacer Reading exam and scored 48-55 on the CAT-W exam.
- Scored 48-55 on the CAT-W exam and 41-54 on the Accuplacer Reading exam.

ENG 101 & ENG 102 SEQUENCE / CRITERIA

- ENG 101 (3 credits, 6 equated/billable) failed CAT-W 48-55 and passing the Accuplacer Reading exam or passing ENG 93.
- ENG 102 (3 credits, 6 equated/billable) passing the CAT-W or passing ENG 93 and failing the CUNY Accuplacer Reading Test with a score of 42-54.
- > ENG 101 is equivalent to ENG 110.
- > ENG 102 is equivalent to ENG 110.
- For Spring 2015, ENG 101 or ENG 102 will satisfy the co-requisites for any course that has ENG 110 as a co-requisite.
