

ADJUNCT POSITIONS WITHIN CUNY FOR THE FALL AND SPRING SEMESTER AT-A-GLANCE

**Adjunct waivers are no longer routinely granted.
They are only granted for limited, unforeseen emergencies. See CUNY Central 2011 memo.**

Not more than **9 classroom contacts hours** per semester at one unit in CUNY*

plus

A maximum of **one course** not more than **6 classroom contact hours** during the same semester at another CUNY unit

OR

Not more than **225 non-teaching adjunct hours** per semester at one unit in CUNY

plus

Not more than **150 non-teaching hours** per semester at a second CUNY unit non-teaching hours for the academic year.

OR

A proportional combination of teaching and non-teaching adjunct hours

(135 minus the assigned teaching hours) divided by **.6**
equals
the number of non-teaching hours that may be assigned per semester

For example, the adjunct is teaching two three-credit courses.

$(135 - 90)/.6 = 45/.6 = 75$

The adjunct can teach two courses and work 75 non-teaching hours

plus

A maximum of one course not more than **6 classroom contact hours** during the same semester at another CUNY unit

*The number of hours in nursing is 180.
