ADJUNCT POSITIONS WITHIN CUNY FOR THE FALL AND SPRING SEMESTER AT-A-GLANCE

Adjunct waivers are no longer routinely granted.

They are only granted for limited, unforeseen emergencies. See CUNY Central 2011 memo.

Not more than 9 classroom contacts hours per semester at one unit in CUNY*

plus

A maximum of **one course** not more than **6 classroom contact hours** during the same semester at another CUNY unit

Not more than 225 non-teaching adjunct hours per semester at one unit in CUNY

plus

OR

Not more than **150** non-teaching hours per semester at a second CUNY unit non-teaching hours for the academic year.

OR

A proportional combination of teaching and nonteaching adjunct hours

(135 minus the assigned teaching hours) divided by .6 equals the number of non-teaching hours that may be assigned per semester For example, the adjunct is teaching two three-credit courses.

(135 - 90)/.6 = 45/.6 = 75

The adjunct can teach two courses and work 75 non-teaching hours

plus

A maximum of one course not more than **6 classroom contact hours** during the same semester at another CUNY unit
