The Humanities Department's modern languages program at Eugenio Maria de Hostos Community College seeks applicants for a tenure track Assistant Professor in French language and Francophone related area studies with strong interdisciplinary interest and practice.

In addition to the above, the selected candidates will perform the following:

- Teach various levels of French and Francophone related areas studies courses; course and curriculum development; research and scholarly activities leading to professional growth.
- Provide student guidance/advisement.
- Develop undergraduate modern language offerings and programming.
- Monitor student clubs of native French speakers.
- Participate in departmental and college assignments, committee assignments, and other tasks normally associated with the responsibilities of a full-time faculty appointment.

- The area-studies developed should complement one of the other related disciplines in the Humanities Department: Black Studies, Latin and Caribbean Studies, Humanities, Philosophy, Visual and Performing Arts or an additional
