DEPARTMENT POLICY FOR CONFERRAL OF TRANSFER CREDIT
(Updated 2017)

CUNY does not have an expiration date on undergraduate courses.

Hostos Community College will accept transfer courses from:

CUNY colleges with a grade of D or better with no time limitations

NON-CUNY colleges with a grade of C or better with no time limitations

With the exception to the departments below, see notes:

DEPARTMENT: Allied Health

UNITS:

NURSING – Liberal arts courses are generally accepted for equivalent courses.

In addition, the following courses require a “B-” or better to be accepted for transfer credit:

ENG 110, MAT 120, BIO 230, BIO 240, BIO 310 and CHE 105

DENTAL HYGIENE - Liberal arts courses are generally accepted for equivalent courses.

In addition, the following courses require a “B-” or better to be accepted for transfer credit:

BIO 230 and BIO 240. For PSY 101, SOC 101, VPA 192 and MAT courses, a grade of “C” or higher is required.

RADIOLOGY - Liberal arts courses are generally accepted for equivalent courses.

In addition, the following courses require a “B-” or better to be accepted for transfer credit:

MAT 120, BIO 230 and BIO 240

DEPARTMENT: Mathematics and Natural Sciences

UNITS:

CHEMICAL, CIVIL, ELECTRICAL and MECHANICAL ENGINEERING SCIENCE –a GPA of 2.8 and a grade of “C” or better in ENG 110, ENG 111, PSY 101, SOC 101, HUM 101, VPA 192 and humanities courses (including History and Spanish) at CUNY or any other USA college. TO meet the math and science requirements, students must have a “B-” or higher in Mathematics (MAT 160, MAT 200, MAT 210, MAT 220, MAT 310, MAT 320, MAT 360) and Science (PHY 210, PHY 220, CHE 210, CHE 220, CHE 310m CHE 312 and CHE 320).
