# **Review of minutes**

- Jerry Rosa reviews Association Bylaws regarding membership
- Motion to appoint student representatives and Association officers: Charles Drago, Muiz Agbaje
  - Vote: 9, 0, 0 motion approved
- Student representatives: Muiz Agbaje, Leana Santana, Lusleidy Pérez, Brian Carter, Amdiya Kyemtore and Reyna Soto
- Association officers: SVP Esther Rodríguez-Chardavoyne (Chair), Johanna Gómez (Deputy Chairperson), Ken Acquah (Treasurer) and Jerry Rosa (Secretary)

#### Budget presentation by Albert Lai

- \$50,226 collected as a result of Summer enrollment
- Nothing spent as of yet

## Review of line balances

- Albert Lai reads balances
- Aponte Fund has a balance of \$2,303.03
- Jerry Rosa gives an explanation of the Aponte Fund

- Fund established after the Men's Basketball Team won its national championship
- Ceremony (gala) was held to raise funds
- Funds raised utilized to assist athletic teams

# Review of earmark spending plans

- Sports & Recreation (Athletics) \$10,667.55
  - Presented by Director Erik Smiles
  - Not aware that Aponte Fund existed will create fundraising efforts
  - Set aside \$1,167.55 towards an e-sports licensing fee
  - O Question: What is the variety of e-sports that you are considering?
    - NJCAA offers 20 sports (football and soccer included)
    - NJCAA pays licensing fee
    - Students can compete for regional and national championship
  - Question: Could we try to set up a tournament for October (begin promoting in September)?
    - Will work on that
  - Question: Do they give prizes?
    - Winners receive plaques
  - The tournament is coed
  - SVP work with Jerry, Jason and SGA to set up the tournament
  - O Question: Do people have to sign in?
    - They have to register
  - SVP could set up a Hostos group
- Student Health Services \$1,422.34
  - o Dean Gómez presents on behalf of Ursula Sanders
  - Health and Wellness has been providing ongoing services to students (food pantry and others)
  - O Question: Will the washable masks have the Hostos logo?
    - Students might ask, "Where can I get one?"
    - SVP would prefer that the mask does not have the logo
- Student Activities \$1,777.92
  - Jerry Rosa gives a summary
- Member Admiya Kyemtore enters meeting
- SGA Stipends \$4,444.81
  - Presented by Muiz Agbaje
  - o Summer one-time stipend
- SGA Programming \$5,333.77
  - Will send out surveys to engage students

- Jerry (Rosa) gave us some (event) ideas
- Might give some gift cards to Athletics (for the e-sports tournament) if we have some left
- SVP I like that SGA is giving out its own "stimulus package"

# <u>Discussion about moving AY 2019-2020 balances</u>

- Albert Lai gives a report no funds available
- Reserve has a balance of over negative \$4,000
- Jerry Rosa since there is no SGA Summer Retreat and part of the funds normally come from Clubs & Organizations, perhaps we could use some of the C&O money to support SGA initiatives
- SVP could help students who owe and do not have enough money to pay
- Muiz Agbaje would like the \$12K to be in the spending power of SGA
- SVP would make friendly amendment that \$10K be used instead of \$12K
- Jerry Rosa would recommend that half be used for hardships, half for SGA initiatives
- Question: What department handles the (hardship) funds?
  - Dean in collaboration with the Bursar's Office
- Dean Gómez emergency need-based grants are handled by the VP's office
  - There is an online form
  - Everything is documented
- Question: What would be some of the requirements (so as not to exclude some students)?
  - Dean vary throughout the years
  - There are processes in place by which all students could receive assistance (some through private donations)
- Motion to allocate \$6,200 (from Clubs & Organizations) towards Tuition Assistance and \$6,245.47 towards SGA Initiatives— Muiz Agbaje, Brian Carter
  - Vote: 10, 0, 0 motion approved

- Question: Can I get a report about the minus \$4,000 plus Reserve balance that was previously mentioned?
  - Albert Lai will work on that
- Brian Carter can we allocated the (Fall) budget for SGA Meetings Food to more useful purposes?
