Minutes of the February 2, 2016, meeting were accepted with one minor correction.

Ms. Nelida Pastoriza provided the CWCC members present with authoritative information on the issue of whether Hostos is, or is not, a “Non-Attendance Institution.” Ms. Pastoriza explained that because of TITLE IV requirements, Hostos is a non-attendance institution. However, teaching faculty can still consider a student’s “class participation” which can also reflect non-attendance in that criteria.
