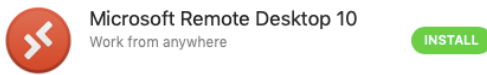
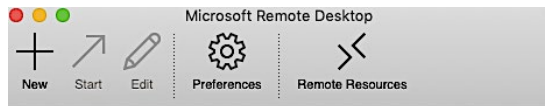


Connecting to your Windows Desktop using from a MAC with Microsoft Remote Desktop

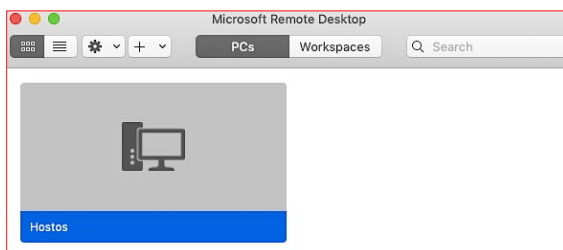
1. After the VPN client (**GlobalProtect**) is installed and configured.
2. Go to your **Apple Store** and search for **Microsoft Remote Desktop 10** . If you have another version you will need to install version 10.
3. Click **Get**, then **Install**.



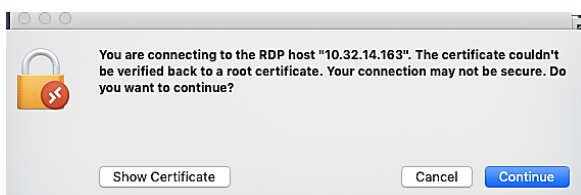
2. Once **Microsoft Remote Desktop** is downloaded, click on **Open** to launch it.
3. Right click on the icon on your **Dock**, then **Options** and **Keep In Dock**.



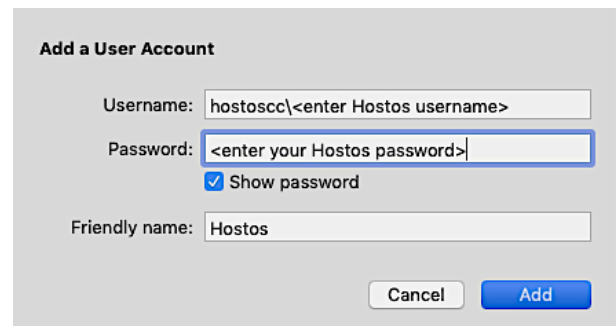
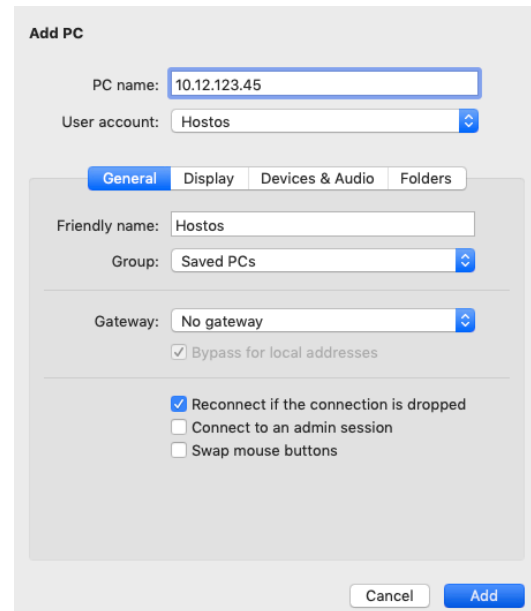
4. Click "**New**" (+) add your Hostos desktop
5. Add the **IP address** or **Computer Name** into the PC name field.
6. Select **User Account** to add your Hostos username and password as seen in the image on the right. You can add a name in the Friendly Name field.
7. Click on "**Add**" when done.
8. Your connection will be saved with a Friendly Name you entered earlier. You will be able to connect by double clicking on the icon (like the one seen below) to connect to your computer



10. You will see a screen similar to this one, click continue to **Connect**.



12. When done with the computer, click on the **Windows** button then **Sign Out**.
13. **Disconnect** from the VPN



9. You will be prompted for access to the camera by the Remote Desktop application, click **Don't Allow**.



11. If the connection is successful you will see the following warning, proceed to log on as you normally would if you were at Hostos. Click **OK** to login to your computer.
