Comments:

*Part Four requires 4 courses from Category A (2-4 courses) and Category B (0-2 courses). At least 2 courses must be from Category A. All Hostos FEEF graduates have earned credit for ACC 251, a Category B course. Hostos students have the option to take BUS 210 / ACC 264 Business Law at Hostos, a Category B course.

**Part Three requires either ECO/SOC 360 (Hostos students may have taken SOC 101 pre-requisite) OR PAD 331 (Hostos FEEF graduates have satisfied pre-requisites).

This plan assumes that students are transferring to John Jay with 60 credits. Students are required to earn 120 total credits in order to graduate with the BS degree.
