The journey was not easy, tackling school work and my job and being a mother of two beautiful children led to unceasing sleepless nights. I remember crying in the library, having to leave class early

2018-2019 Dean's List

These students did not have any withdrawals, repeats, incompletes, D, or F grades. The 2019-2020 Dean's List awardees will be honored during the 2021 Honors Convocation.

Scholastic Achievement

The Scholastic Achievement Award is earned by students who graduate with a cumulative grade point average of 3.7 or higher. Traditionally, these students are recognized by their gold stoles which are bestowed during the Honors Convocation ceremony and worn by the honorees during the college's commencement (graduation) ceremony.


