Meeting Objectives

The purpose of the meeting is to hear CAC members' perspectives on the future of the healthcare industry within the region and identify opportunities and initiatives that Hostos Community College might explore to meet the needs of the communities it serves.

To spark a discussion, the planning team will present a brief overview of data from the U.S. Census and the New York State Department of Labor that highlights issues relevant to the healthcare industry in the region.

3. Industry Topics (15 minutes)

Participants will be invited to share their perspectives on current and anticipated trends in healthcare in the Bronx, northern Manhattan and across the region.

- What are the salient trends and issues regionally?
- How might the industry look differently ten years from now?

4. Known Challenges (15 minutes)

- What obstacles do students seeking careers in healthcare currently face?
- What are some of the systemic challenges in these fields?

5. Hostos Strengths (15 minutes)

- What existing Hostos programming might serve as a base on which to build future success?
- Are there Hostos-specific characteristics or relationships that uniquely position the College to be a leader in this field or to face the challenges identified above?

6. Regional Opportunities (15 minutes)

- What are the local bright spots with which the College should connect to leverage future opportunities in the field?
 - community leaders in the industry that will shape its future
 - institutions that are navigating evolving challenges
